#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

R-56® is composed of surface active agents and organic polymers that help reduce surface tension and aid in pesticide retention on plants. R-56 can be used with a wide range of agricultural chemicals, especially wettable powders or dry flowable formulations of fungicides and insecticides. R-56 helps agricultural chemicals adhere to the plant surface thus resisting "wash off" during wet conditions. R-56 is designed for use with agricultural fungicides, herbicides, insecticides, and defoliants to speed wetting, give more uniform coverage and improve adhesion between the pesticide and the plant surface.

#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

Care must be taken when spraying sensitive crops.

Always add R-56 as the last ingredient to the tank with agitator running. Pesticides should be well mixed before addition of R-56.

For pesticides/herbicides that permit use of a surfactant at a higher rate, follow instructions on that pesticide/herbicide label. However, DO NOT ADD THIS PRODUCT AT A RATE WHICH EXCEEDS 5% OF THE FINISHED SPRAY VOLUME.

Use caution at the higher application rates. When applying to a sensitive crop, first treat a small area to determine if there may be adverse effects on the crop.

#### **USE RATES**

**HERBICIDES:** Use 1 to 3 pints (16 to 48 fl. oz.) per 100 gallons of spray solution. **INSECTICIDES:** Use 1/8 to 2 pints (2 to 32 fl. oz.) per 100 gallons of spray solution. **FUNGICIDES AND ACARICIDES:** Use 1/8 to 2 pints (2 to 32 fl. oz.) per 100 gallons of spray solution. **DEFOLIANTS AND DESICCANTS:** Use 1 to 4 pints (16 to 64 fl. oz.) per 100 gallons of spray solution. **BACKPACK OR HANDHELD SPRAYERS:** Use 1/2 to 1 teaspoon per gallon of spray solution.

Before using R-56 on stone or pome fruit, consult your Wilbur-Ellis fieldman or licensed consultant.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
